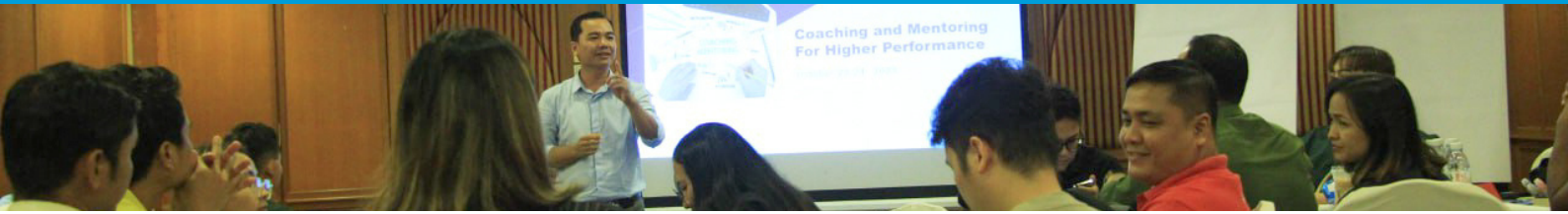


HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES
